

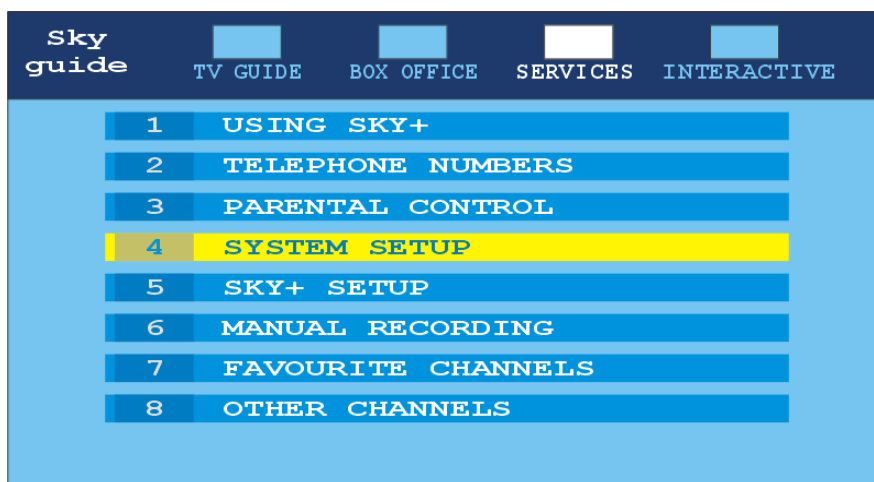
## Introduction.

In the UK we have three main Digital TV sources, Sky, cable and Freeview, which are all able to output RGB. Many of our converters require RGB and one of the most common questions is how to enable RGB output. This guide will go through three scenarios covering the three main digital TV sources:

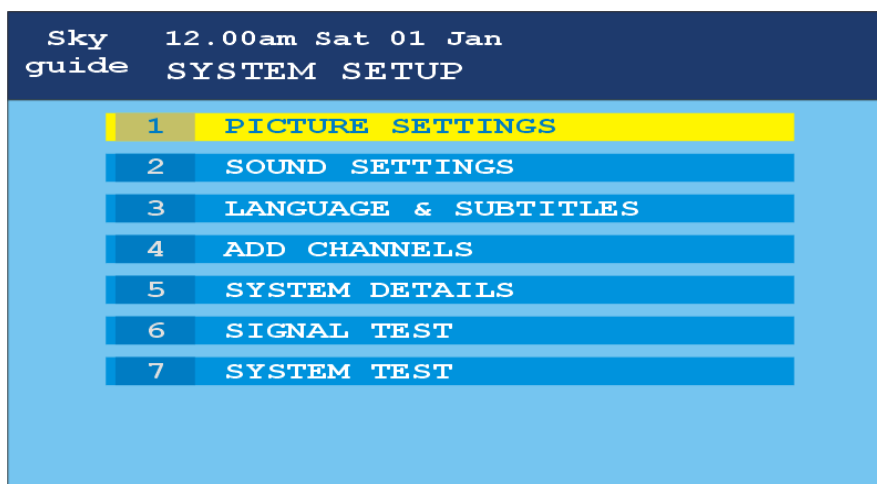
1. Sky and Sky+.
2. NTL and Telewest Digital Cable Services.
3. Freeview.

## Sky and Sky+.

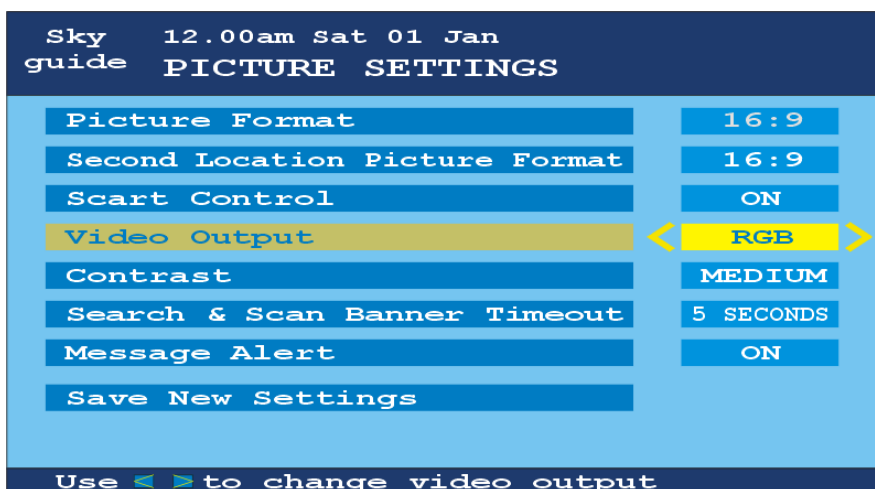
Press the **Services** button on the remote control to bring up relevant menu. Select option 4, System Setup



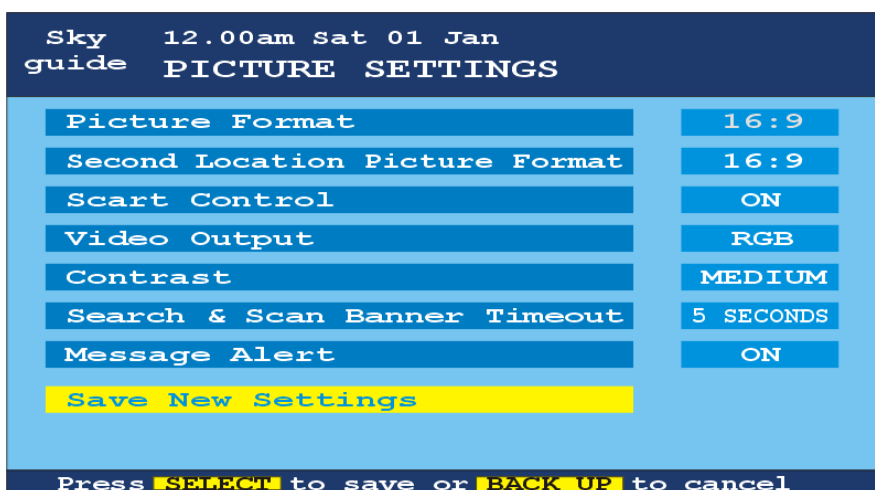
Choose **Picture Settings**.



Navigate down to **Video Output** and use the left / right buttons to show **RGB**.



Highlight **Save New Settings** and press **Select** on the remote control.



RGB is now enabled. Do not press the **TV** button as this will suspend RGB output. If this occurs, simply by pressing the **Sky** button RGB output will be re-enable.

### NTL and Telewest Digital Cable Services.

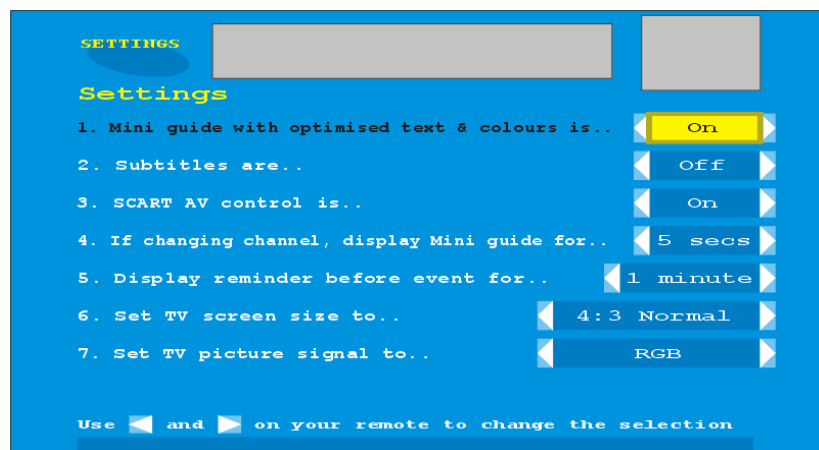
Press the **Guide** button on the remote to bring up the following menu.



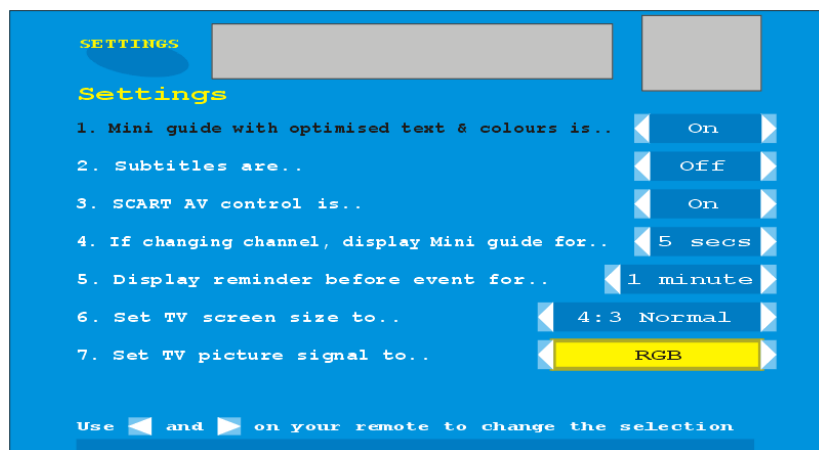
Navigate across to **Settings** options and press select.



Select **Visual Settings**.



Highlight **Option 7** and set the TV picture to **RGB**.

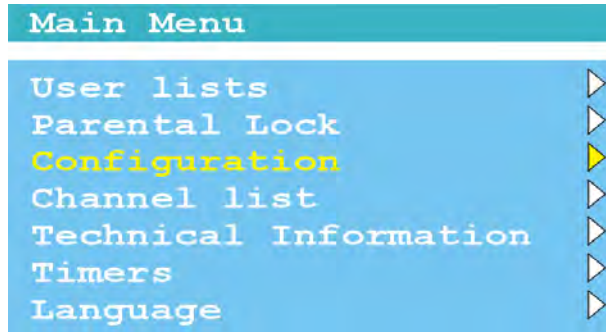


Press **TV** to return to normal function. This completes the setup process for digital cable.

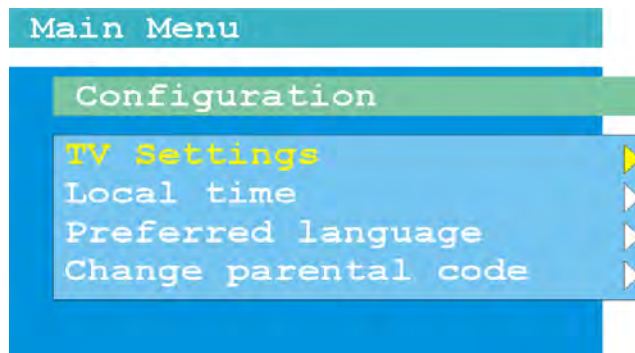
## Freeview.

Each Freeview digital set top box manufacturer has a different menu screen, but they are essentially similar for setting up RGB output. We are using one of the most popular manufactures' menu screens as an example of how to set up RGB output.

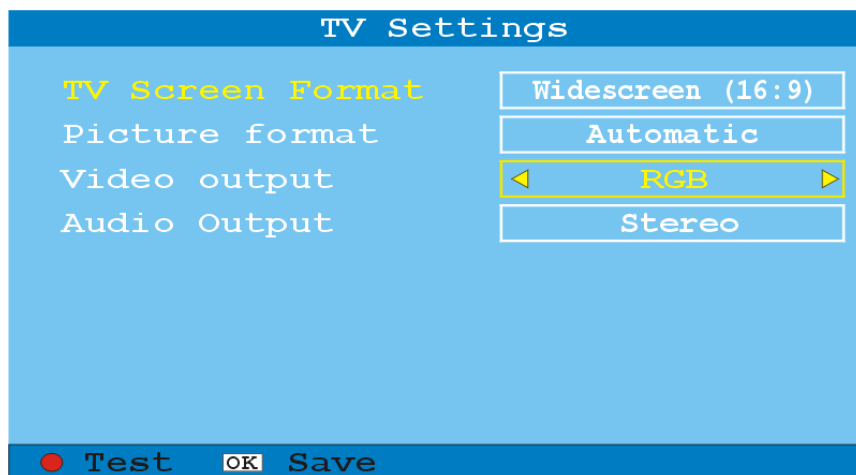
Press the **Menu** button on the remote control.



Select the **Configuration** menu option.



Move down to **Video Output** and use the left / right scroll buttons to select **RGB**.



Press **OK** to save settings. RGB should now be enabled.

## **Conclusion.**

Using the menu screens on Digital TV, RGB can easily be switched on. Other digital video sources, such as DVD player, DVD recorders and TiVo can be configured in a similar method.
